



## Things You Should Know...

- ◆ 9 Advanced Placement courses are offered in Upper School.
- ◆ 41% of Upper School students are members of the National Honor Society.
- ◆ 43% of Middle School students are members of the National Junior Honor Society.
- ◆ 68% of students in grades 7 to 12 are members of the Duke University Scholar Program.
- ◆ Students begin taking the SAT in grade 9.
- ◆ Trinity is a TAKS-free school. The Stanford Achievement Test is administered to students in Kindergarten through grade 9 each year and is used to measure student growth from year to year.
- ◆ 100% of Trinity students are college-bound.
- ◆ Affordability is made easier through Trinity's need-based tuition assistance program.
- ◆ 23% of the student body represents ethnically diverse groups. International students from 4 different foreign countries comprise 5% of the student body.
- ◆ 63% of Middle and Upper School students participate in at least one sport. Students can choose from basketball, volleyball, soccer, tennis, golf, track, football, and cheerleading. Trinity teams compete state-wide with other schools through the Texas Association of Parochial and Private Schools (TAPPS).
