Trinity School of Texas Uniform Policy

The Trinity School of Texas dress code is established to foster school spirit, instill pride, and promote a unified, cohesive school community. Trinity encourages individual expression based on character, abilities, and talents rather than style and label of clothing. Students are expected to comply with the dress code.

Uniform Policy – Early Childhood and Lower School

Students are expected to look neat at all times. Clothes must be clean, ironed, and without holes or tears. Jumper, skirt, skort, and short lengths must be no more than three inches above the knee. Shoe heel height should be no more than one inch high. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times. The dress code is in effect throughout the day and when students are representing the school. Parents are expected to take an active role in helping their children conform to the dress code.

Uniform Policy – Middle and Upper School

Students are expected to look neat at all times. Clothes must be clean, ironed, and without holes or tears. Clothes must fit properly with no tight clothing or “skinny leg” style permitted. Skirt and short length must be no more than three inches above the knee. Shoe heel height should be no more than one inch high. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times. Jewelry and makeup that are distracting are not allowed. Body piercing is not allowed. Men will not wear earrings. Hair must be well groomed and should not be dyed an unnatural color. Men’s hair must be trimmed above the collar and eyebrows with no facial hair. The dress code is in effect throughout the day and when students are representing the school. Parents are expected to take an active role in helping their children conform to the dress code.

A student who does not conform to the dress code will be subject to disciplinary actions.

Sources for clothing:

Lands’ End is our preferred uniform provider, and we recommend that uniform pieces be purchased from them. For your convenience, we offer Lollipops and Lace as a local uniform provider. Although it is not required that you purchase uniform items from Lands’ End or Lollipops and Lace, **any other options must conform in every way to the items at Lands’ End and Lollipops and Lace.** It is important that a consistent appearance be maintained in students’ dress.

The Trinity School of Texas Parent Teacher Council (PTC) manages a store, the Trinity Trading Company, where gently worn uniform items are available for a suggested donation amount. Donations of outgrown pieces are always welcome. All proceeds from used uniform sales go to the PTC to help fund school projects.
